The Pennsylvania Council on the Arts awards non-matching fellowships, in fixed amounts of \$5,000 or \$10,000, to eligible Pennsylvania artists of talent to enable them to pursue their artistic goals. The PCA selects these artists using qualified juries of arts professionals whose recommendations are submitted to the Council for final approval. Fellowship awards are highly competitive, only a small percentage of applicants receive awards.

Categories being reviewed for 2007 Deadline

Deadline: August 1, 2007

- **Dance:** Choreography
- **Folk and Traditional Arts:** Performing Traditions and Apprenticeships
- **Literature:** Poetry
- **Media Arts:** Narrative and Documentary
- **Music:** Classical Composition
- **Theatre:** Scriptworks
- **Visual Arts:** Painting or Drawing/Artists Books/Printmaking or New Technologies/Other Genres
